

**HUNDRED AND FIFTY AT LORD'S  
AN COOK JOINS THE SELECT BAND**

Alister Cook joined the select band of batsmen who have scored a hundred and a fifty at Lords's when he made 105 and 65 against West Indies in the just concluded first test at Lord's. His feat provides the 22<sup>nd</sup> such instance at Lord's. He is the second batsman after MP Vaughan to perform the feat against West Indies.
